### POSITION SUMMARY

The painter prepares, paints or finishes a variety of surfaces inside and outside schools and other Board sites, performs general maintenance work, and works within safety regulations and the fire code to protect against injury and facility damage.

### DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Inspect site to determine requirements for material and labour.
- Prepare surfaces for painting and apply finishes.
- Deliver and set up materials such as scaffolding, ladder, tarps, etc.
- Remove graffiti from indoor and outdoor surfaces.
- Work from sketches to apply lines and designs.
- Operate equipment such as spray gun, electric lift or power hand tools.
- Perform a variety of building, installation, repair and maintenance tasks.
- Comply with all building, fire and safety code requirements.
- Provide costing estimates to school, offices and supervisors.
- Consult with school and board office administrators to schedule projects.
- Provide guidance to contractors and other maintenance staff.
- Prioritize work orders, record information for time and materials.
- Operate a board vehicle meeting all safety and maintenance guidelines.

### EDUCATION

Completion of a current Certificate of Qualification as a Painter and licensed to work in Ontario.

### EXPERIENCE

Three and one half years of related work experience is required.
